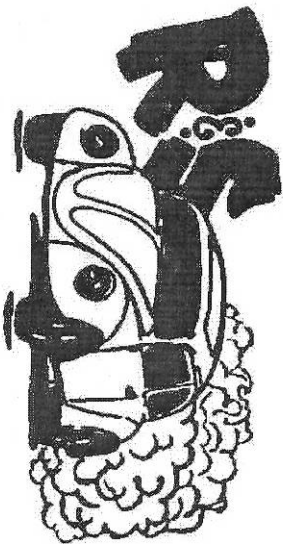

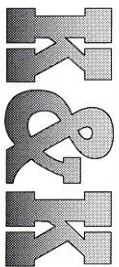

NEW CC DEBUTS AT LA NEXT WEEK



What looked at first like a niche has developed into a completely new segment: nearly 270,000 people around the world have bought Volkswagen's CC sedan that has the looks and heart of a sports car. Last in VW's lineup to get a design refresh, it was time to bring CC more in line with the rest of the new VW design language. Volkswagen is presenting a technically and visually updated version of the vehicle at the LA Auto Show, held at the LA Convention Center in downtown Los Angeles between November 18 and 27. The market launch phase begins shortly thereafter.

New grill treatment that now includes new bi-xenon headlights, static cornering lights, and new bumpers. In back there is a new LED tail light design. Inside are new door panels with stainless steel door sill plates. Also standard: fatigue detection, RCD 310 radio-CD system, and safety head restraints with additional longitudinal adjustment for the front seats. Volkswagen will first offer the new CC in Germany in February 2012, then in stages across Europe, America, Russia, China (local version starting in 2013) and all other sales regions relevant to this vehicle class. The 2012 Volkswagen CC will go on sale in the Spring in the U.S. Feature and model lineup changes specific to the U.S. market will be released closer to launch in the Spring of 2012.

When the Volkswagen CC made its debut four years ago, it was the first four-door coupé in the 30,000 to 40,000 euro class. Now, Volkswagen is presenting a technically and visually updated version of the popular business vehicle. With new front and rear styling, the new perfected Volkswagen CC makes an even bolder move towards the automotive luxury class. Its extended range of standard features has become more exclusive as well;

New assistance systems are making their way into the CC as well. They include optional technologies such as Side Assist Plus with integrated Lane Assist (warns of vehicles in blind spots and assists driver in avoiding an accident by steering intervention), Dynamic Light Assist (automatic main beam control) that is new in the Volkswagen CC and a camera-based traffic sign detection system. Meanwhile, comfort is optimized by the 'climate seat' with integrated massage function.

If you are going to Dave and Addie's, remember to bring your favorite cookies to exchange with everyone. *Always lots of fun!*

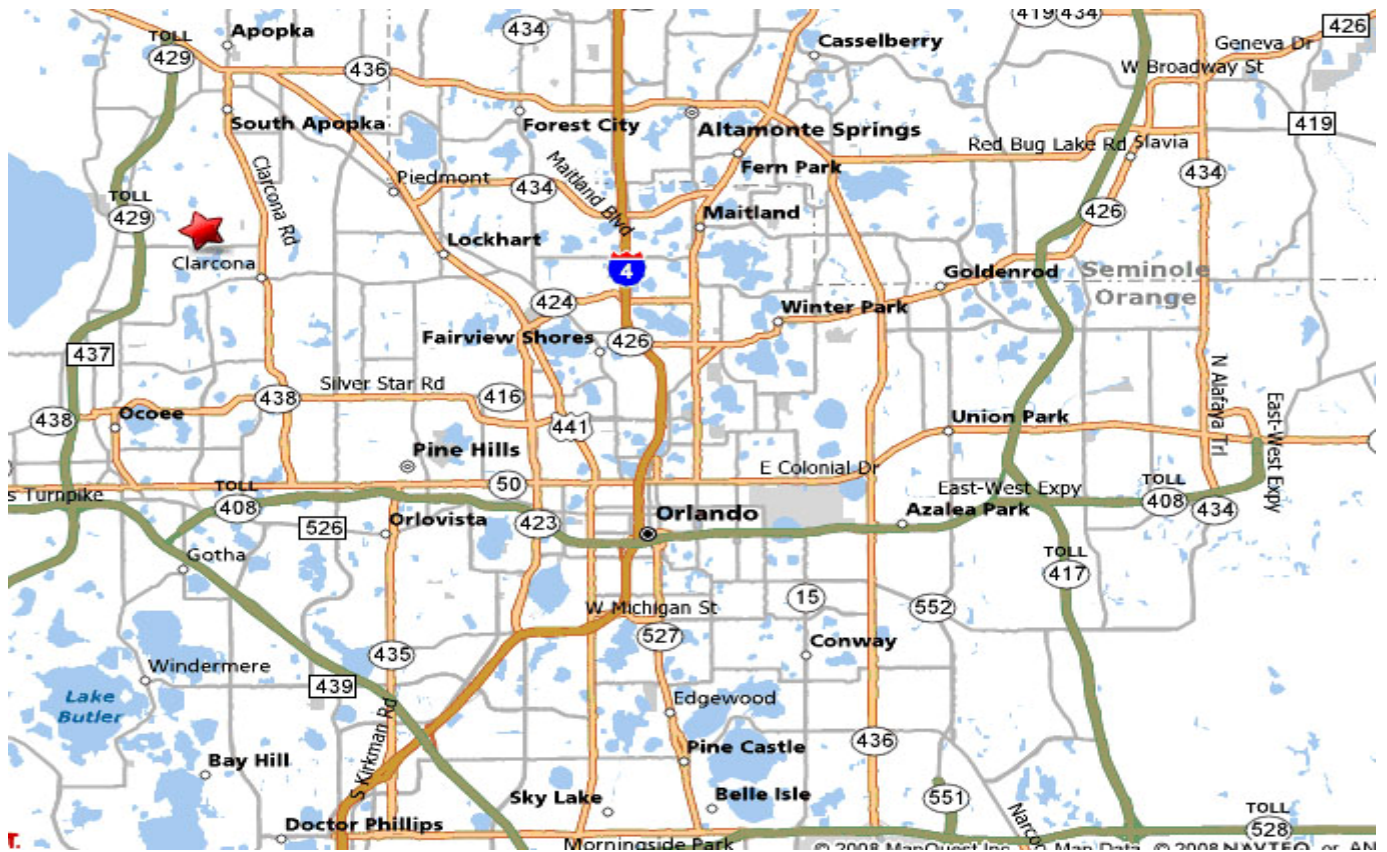
Meeting is at 2pm.

DIRECTION TO DAVE AND ADDIES' HOUSE (*From 5 and Diner*)

1. Start out going EAST on E COLONIAL DR/ COLONIAL DR E/ FL-50 E/ JOHN CHENEY HWY toward CRICKET CLB. **(.2 mi)**
2. Take the SR-408-TOLL W ramp toward ORLANDO/ OCOEE. **(.4 mi)**
3. Merge onto FL-408 TOLL W/ EAST-WEST EXPY (Portions toll). **(17.9 mi)**
4. Take the HIAWASSEE RD exit, EXIT 4. **(.4 mi)**
5. Turn RIGHT onto N HIAWASSEE RD/ HIAWASSEE RD N. **(.2 mi)**
6. Turn LEFT onto COLONIAL DR W/ W COLONIAL DR/ FL-50. **(.8 mi)**
7. Turn RIGHT onto APOPKA VINELAND RD N/ APOPKA VINELAND RD N. **(5.1 mi)**
8. Turn LEFT onto E MCCORMICK RD. **(1.1 mi.)**
9. Turn LEFT onto BROMFIELD DR. **(.3 mi)**
10. End at **3493 Bromfield Dr Ocoee, FL 34761-5106**

Estimated Time: 33 minutes Estimated Distance: 26.36 miles



If you are coming from the North: Take I-4 to 436 Go west on 436 to the intersection of Park Ave South. Turn Left and head south. This road becomes Clarcona Road then Apopka Vineland. Turn right onto E. McCormick Road and left onto Bromfield Dr.
